





Safeguarding Training

As part of the Church's ongoing commitment to safeguarding, the Catholic Trust for England and Wales has purchased a package of e-learning programmes available to all members of the Catholic community free of charge. *Training is a mandatory requirement for all volunteers in roles involving children and adults who may be vulnerable. The relevant modules will need to be completed before commencing in role.* The modules currently available are:

- Child Protection & Child Protection Refresher
- Child Protection in Education
- An Introduction to Child Sexual Exploitation
- Online Safety
- Safeguarding Adults & Safeguarding Adults Refresher
- Mental Capacity



What do I need to do to access this training resource?

- 1. To register your interest please email: safeguardingadmin@hallam-diocese.com
- 2. Your email should contain your name, the name of your parish/order/congregation, and your role (for example: Priest; member of the Religious; Safeguarding Representative; Youth Worker; Teacher; SVP/Volunteer; Parent/Grandparent/Guardian; Other.
- 3. On receipt of your email the safeguarding administrator will register your email address with EduCare.
- 4. You will receive a welcome email from EduCare inviting you to set your password.
- 5. You will then have instant access to the training programmes.
