General Data Protection Regulations (GDPR)

How we use your information

We are committed to collecting and using personal information responsibly, proportionately, securely and fairly.

Information that we hold in relation to individuals is known as "personal data". - We have in place administrative, technical and physical measures designed to guard against and minimise the risk of loss, misuse or unauthorised *processing* or disclosure of the *personal data* that we hold.
