Responsorial Psalm- Psalm 33(34):2-7

*Taste and see that the Lord is good.*

I will bless the Lord at all times,  
his praise always on my lips;  
in the Lord my soul shall make its boast.  
The humble shall hear and be glad.

*Do we stop at all different moments in the day and acknowledge God's presence simply?*

*On Mothering Sunday we pray and thank God for all who in their humility have shown us a mother's love*

Glorify the Lord with me.

Together let us praise his name.  
I sought the Lord and he answered me;  
from all my terrors he set me free.

*How and when do we share prayer together with others, united in our baptism as God's people?*

*What is our sense of God setting us free to live as his daughter or son by baptism?*

let your faces not be abashed.

This poor man called, the Lord heard him  
and rescued him from all his distress.

*Do our faces [or our way of life] show how much we enjoy our faith for how it benefits our lives?*

*Think about God's preference for the poor, and what we need to do to rescue others where we can.*
