Responsorial Psalm- Psalm 102(103):1-4,6-8,11

Pray for the Jewish people to be faithful, and pray especially for those hurt by anti-Semitism*

For as the heavens are high above the earth
so strong is his love for those who fear him.
*Ask that you will imitate God by being slow to anger and rich in mercy.
Pray that we will live our baptism conscious of the holiness of God*
