Responsorial Psalm

Psalm 145(146):6-10

This psalm of praise expresses complete trust in God whatever our personal situation.

God has shown himself faithful throughout the history of his people, so he will do now, and for all times.

COME, LORD, AND SAVE US.

It is the Lord who keeps faith for ever,
who is just to those who are oppressed.

Thank God for the good gifts we enjoy in our own lives as we see how he supports those in need.

Pray for and ask what can we do for the burdened, the stranger, the widow and orphan this Advent time?

It is the Lord who loves the just
but thwarts the path of the wicked.

The Lord will reign for ever,
Zion's God, from age to age.

Reflect and thank God for the people who promote justice in our lives and for the world

Our God reigns for all time. Stop and ask what that means for you in the hurly burly of Christmas preparations.
