Pray for all the families and peoples who are part of the universal Church with you.

Think about what you can make as a new offering to God today

Worship the Lord in his temple.

O earth, tremble before him.

Proclaim to the nations: 'God is king.'

He will judge the peoples in fairness.

If you can visit a church, or just find a quiet space as your temple, and simply worship the Lord
