Psalm 31(32):1-2,5,11

YOU ARE MY REFUGE, O LORD; YOU FILL ME WITH THE JOY OF SALVATION.

Happy the man whose offence is forgiven, whose sin is remitted. O happy the man to whom the Lord imputes no guilt, in whose spirit is no guile. *Give thanks that we are blessed [happy] for we know God can forgive our sins by his grace Try to realise how amazing it is that God can take away the guilt of our sin*
