Responsorial Psalm

Psalm 94(95):1-2,6-9

O that today you would listen to his voice! 'Harden not your hearts.'

Come, ring out our joy to the Lord;

hail the rock who saves us.

Let us come before him, giving thanks,

with songs let us hail the Lord.

Take time to praise God for the way you have been able to depend on him as a rock in your life

Thank God for the faith you have and the good people and things of your life

Come in; let us bow and bend low;

let us kneel before the God who made us:

for he is our God and we

the people who belong to his pasture,

the flock that is led by his hand.

It's important to reflect on God's generosity in making himself known to us in Christ, a gift we do not deserve

Thank God for belonging to the community of faith, the Church, with its joys and challenges

'Harden not your hearts as at Meribah,

as on that day at Massah in the desert

when your fathers put me to the test;

when they tried me, though they saw my work.'
